

Admission Eligibility Criteria

Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm)

Eligibility (as per PCI & CET Cell Guidelines):

1. The candidate must be an Indian National possessing Domicile Certificate
2. Should have passed Class XII / HSC or equivalent exam with Physics & Chemistry as core subjects along with Mathematics or Biology.
3. Must have secured a minimum of 45% marks (40% for reserved categories of Maharashtra) in the above subjects combined.
4. Must have a non-zero score in MHT-CET (2025 or latest as applicable).
5. Preference is given to MHT-CET & NEET for All India candidates.

Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm)

Eligibility (as per PCI & MSBTE norms):

1. Indian nationality is mandatory possessing Domicile Certificate
2. Must have completed 10+2 (Science stream) with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects, and Maths or Biology as optional.
3. Minimum aggregate of 35% marks required in qualifying examination.
4. No entrance exam; admissions are based on merit of HSC Marks

Lateral Entry to Second Year B. Pharm

For D. Pharm holders seeking direct admission into 2nd Year B. Pharm:

- Should have passed Diploma in Pharmacy from a PCI-approved institute.
- Must have scored minimum 50%
- Admission is as per DTE & MSBTE, CET Cell / University of Mumbai norms for lateral entry.
