



Rules and regulations to be followed by students during an exam

1. Students must arrive at the exam venue and be seated 10 minutes before the scheduled exam time.
2. Students must carry a Valid ID card/ hall ticket and must occupy the designated seats only. Change of seats is not permitted.
3. Students must maintain absolute silence in the exam hall. No communication among students is permitted either within or outside the exam hall.
4. Exam stationery (pens, pencils, rulers, erasers, sharpeners) should be carried in transparent pouches only. Scientific calculators are permitted in the exam hall.
5. No written matter (notes, textbooks or paper) is allowed in the exam hall.
6. Electronic devices, including mobile phones, calculators, smart watches, Bluetooth speakers etc. are not permitted.
7. The students should verify the question paper and answer booklet before starting the exam. Any discrepancies in the question paper or damage in the answer booklet should be brought to the notice of the supervisor.
8. The answer booklet should be written in black or blue only. Diagrams should be drawn with pencil only. Use of red or green pens is not allowed.
9. Students should write their Roll numbers and required details on the answer booklet and in no way reveal their identity anywhere in the answer booklet.
10. Any form of malpractice copying, impersonation, misbehavior like disrupting the exam, use of abusive language, etc. in the exam hall will not be tolerated. The student will have to face the unfair means committee and if found guilty can be debarred from the exam.
