Soujanya Bhumkar, MS, MBA Soujanya is a serial tech entrepreneur based in Palo Alto. Currently he is a co-founder of GEN1E Lifesciences Inc., a clinical-stage, Phase 2 company advancing AI-driven precision medicines for immunology, inflammation, and rare diseases. At GEN1E, he leads the AI/ML team for generating unprecedented efficiency in drug development and applying precision approach for improving Probability of Technical and Regulatory Success (PTRS). GEN1E is advancing a pipeline of four novel precision therapies, including one product in Phase 2 and one in Phase 1, and has 52 granted patents. It's lead program, GEN-1124, a host-directed, novel small-molecule dual-signal modulator, advanced from discovery to Phase 2 in ~2.5 years and has received U.S. FDA Fast Track designation.

Soujanya also serves as Strategic Advisor to Inflect Health, a wholly owned subsidiary of the largest democratic physician partnership in the U.S., representing more than 6000 doctors across 700 hospitals and treating over 10 million patients annually. Previously, Soujanya was Vice President of Global Partnerships at Yahoo, where he led revenue-generating partnerships with top developers and carriers around the world. Prior to Yahoo, Soujanya was co-founder and CEO of Cooliris, which was acquired by Yahoo in 2014.

Earlier in his career, Soujanya co-founded Vazu and Tamarind, both technology startups, and was head of all-things-business at Panopticon, where he led the company's integration into Kana following its \$108 million acquisition.

Soujanya holds an MBA from the University of Chicago, a Master's in Chemical Engineering from the University of Oklahoma, and a Bachelor's in Chemical Engineering from ICT (UDCT). He is a frequent speaker at entrepreneurship forums, and is passionate about collaborating with exceptional teams to contribute awesomeness to the world.
